What is required for me to be OSHA complaint, to avoid being cited and fined?

- 1) Inspection report of your clinic listing potential hazards and controls you have in place to protect your employees
- 2) Personalized site-specific (not just industry specific but SITE specific) OSHA safety manual addressing :
 - a) Your inspection results- hazards and protections
 - b) PPE requirements – duties and PPE reqd
 - c) General safety
 - d) Emergency Action Plan including what to do about patients (hint: human safety comes first)
 - e) Fire safety plan
 - f) Chemical Safety plan
 - g) Animal Behavior and Handling
 - h) Ergonomics
 - i) Workplace Violence
 - j) Compassion Fatigue information
 - k) Chemo protocols (if applicable)
 - l) Other site specific safety precautions and protocols
- 3) MSDS for applicable chemicals available to employees
- 4) Labels on secondary containers
- 5) Employee training
- 6) Updates plan for regulations and training
